

*BY-LAW N^o 100 Property Transfer Tax

EXTRACT of the regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Hudson held at the Hudson Town Hall on September 6th, 1977 at which the following By-Law was adopted:

BY-LAW N° 100

CONCERNING THE LEVY AND COLLETION OF DUTIES ON TRANSFERS OF IMMOVEABLES

It was **moved** by Councillor Guy Séguin and **seconded** by Councillor Yves Séguin that:

- 1. The Town of Hudson is hereby authorized to levy duties on the transfer of an immoveable situated within its territory, at the rate of three-tenths of one percent of the value of the consideration of such transfer up to \$50,000. of such value, and six-tenths of one percent of the excess, in accordance with the provisions of the Act authorizing Municipalities to collect duties on transfers of immoveables. (1976, Bill No. 47, Chapter 30).
- 2. The duties contemplated in Article 1 will be collected according to the said Act.
- 3. The present by-law shall come into force according to the said Act.
