



EXTRACT of Minutes of the regular meeting of the Council of the Town of Hudson held at Ste. Mary's Parish Hall on December 4th, 1989, during which the following by-law was adopted:

BY-LAW N^O 232

**CONCERNING THE POSTPONEMENT, ON THE YEAR OF A
REGULAR ELECTION, OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
GENERALLY HELD ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF NOVEMBER TO THE
SECOND MONDAY FOLLOWING THE DAY OF THE ELECTION**

WHEREAS regular council meetings are held on the first Monday of each month;

WHEREAS on the year of a general election, the voting takes place on the first Sunday of November;

WHEREAS the candidates elected following the vote cannot sit before having been declared elected and having been sworn in;

WHEREAS the elected candidates cannot be declared elected before the expiry of a delay of four days following the end of the vote compilation;

WHEREAS in accordance with article 319 of the Cities and Towns Act (L.R.Q., C.C-19), le council may, with the adoption of a By-Law, move the date of a regular meeting;

WHEREAS there is cause the year of a regular election to move the regular council meeting from the first Monday of November to the second Monday following the day of the election;

CONSEQUENTLY, it is **moved** by Councillor Pierre Frappier and **seconded** by Councillor Diana Togneri that By-Law bearing No 232 is hereby enacted and decreed as follows:

1. The year of a regular election, when there is an election, the regular council meeting of the first Monday of November is moved to the second Monday following the election day.
2. The said by-law will come into force according to the law.
