### 2. <u>484 D Main Road : New business signs</u>

WHEREAS an application has been received for a new business sign at 484 D Main Road;

**THEREFORE** it is <u>moved</u> and unanimously resolved that the Town Planning Advisory Committee <u>recommends</u> the approval of the proposal as submitted with the following condition:

- The sign must not exceed 3ft x 3ft
- The sign may be placed on any column EXCLUDING the column in the corner

## 3. Modification to fencing by-law

**WHEREAS** the Planning Department will be updating the fencing by-law

**THEREFORE** it is recommended by the TPAC that the fencing by-law be updated with the following **conditions:** 

- All new fences and gates will require a permit;
- Gates must not exceed 1.8 meters (6 feet) in height;
- no fence nor pillar should be higher than 1.2 meters (4 feet 0 inches) including the pillars that are retaining the gates and an additional 6 inches will be permitted as a cap on top of the pillars only;
- By-Law on pool fencing will follow the provincial by-law;

**THEREFORE** the town Planning Department will submit a revised draft of the by-law to the TPAC prior to submitting to council.
