WRITTEN PUBLIC CONSULTATION JANUARY 24 to FEBRUARY 7, 2022

Draft by-law 525.3-2021 to further amend the Planning Program – Protection of Natural Areas

The Town has begun the process of modifying the Planning Program to increase the **protection of natural areas** throughout its territory.

Protection measures can include,

- A wetlands conservation plan,
- Amendments to the zoning by-law to add standards for the protection of wetlands, for example, by limiting the backfilling and the cutting of trees,
- Amendments to the subdivision bylaw to regulate the subdivision of properties located in natural environments of interest.
