

DEALING WITH SANDBAGS, BRANCHES, DEBRIS, BULKY ITEMS and PRIVATE WELLS



Once the water has receded

SANDBAGS

3 options

1. Keep the sandbags and store them for future use,
2. Transport them to the snow dump, located at 26 Wharf Road, and leave them in the designated location, or
3. Hire a contractor to dispose of them for you.

Reminder : using sand to raise the level of properties in the floodplain is forbidden. Contravention will lead to the imposition of penalties provided for in by-law 526, section 206.

BRANCHES

Registration required

MAY 23RD BRANCH COLLECTION

To register call 450-458-5347 before 4 pm, May 18th

Quick reminders:

- a maximum branch diameter of 10 cm
- branches placed at curbside latest 7 a.m. Tuesday May 23rd.
- place larger ends of the branches towards the street
- logs, stumps, roots, or branches with debris/garbage (e.g.: stones, metal pieces, green residues) are not accepted.

DEBRIS

- ✓ Use these containers for flood debris only. Place branches at the end of your driveway for branch collection (don't forget to register).

BULKY ITEMS

Items accepted:

Wood furniture (couch, chair, desk, table) and carpets

PRIVATE WELLS

If your private well has been flooded, it is strongly recommended to have your water tested to determine if your well has been contaminated.
