



Firefighter / first responder part-time on call

The Hudson Fire Department is looking for interested and motivated candidates to take on new challenges, to join a dynamic team with an interest in the community and who are willing to devote their time to an expanding fire department.

Job Description:

Under the responsibility of the officers of the fire service, the person holding this position is assigned to responding to emergency calls, either fire or medical as well as called upon to participate in prevention and public education activities.

Summary of tasks:

- Respond to emergency calls and carry out the work requested by your superior;
- Carry out the various maintenance tasks entrusted to you;
- Participate in prevention and public education activities developed by fire department management;
- Perform tasks aimed at preventing fires and intervening in emergency situations;
- Perform external guard duty on the first responder team;
- Actively participate in various exercises, training and practices when requested by fire department management;
- Vigilantly apply and respect the standards, regulations and directives of the fire department.

The above tasks reflect the characteristics of the main elements of the work to be accomplished and should not be considered an exhaustive list.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Hold the minimum qualifications, either a Firefighter 1 certificate from the National school for Firefighters in Quebec (ENPQ) or equivalent training, or commit to following the training in order to act as a firefighter as required by the MSP according to the *regulations on the conditions for working within a municipal fire safety service*;
- Hold or commit to obtaining the skills relating to the role of First Responder according to the requirements of the Integrated University Health and Social Services Center of the Montérégie (CIUSSS);
- Possess a valid driver's license;

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Have your domicile or commit to establishing your domicile in accordance with the sector predetermined by the management of the service (within 7km of the fire station);

Required profile:

- Be able to work on an on-call basis,
- Have the spirit and desire to work as a team;
- Ensure high availabilities;
- Have a good physical condition so as not to interfere with your work in emergency response.

Working conditions:

Salary and working conditions are governed by the current work agreement for the part-time Hudson firefighters.
