



## TABLE OF MAJOR CHANGES INCORPORATED INTO BY-LAW 767.1-2024 AND 767.2-2024 TO OBTAIN REGIONAL CONFORMITY

By-law 767-2024 has been split into two by-laws:

- By-law 767.1-2024 containing only the elements of the by-law that did not cause approval to be withheld;
- By-law 767.2-2024 containing only those elements of the by-law that caused approval to be withheld, with the necessary adaptations to ensure conformity.

Topic of the by-law	Modifications made in by-law 767.2-2024
Uses allowed in all zones	Addition of the following exceptions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The use « conservation area » is only permitted as accessory use in zones P-42, P-43, R-44, Rec-45, A-46 and P-68;</li> <li>- The use « parks, playgrounds, green spaces, open spaces, recreational trails and interpretation trails, including their urban furniture, as well as conservation areas » is only permitted as accessory use in zones R-1, R-3, R-11, R-48, R-51 and R-52;</li> </ul> <p><i><a href="#">The zoning map can be consulted here.</a></i></p>
Documents required for a permit application for the cutting of trees located in the wooded areas and metropolitan forest corridors	Addition of the obligation to submit, for any tree cutting permit for trees located in the wooded areas and metropolitan forest corridors : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A schematic plan of the woods;</li> <li>- An up-to-scale plan indicating the location of the trees to be cut;</li> <li>- The dimensions and species of the trees to be cut;</li> <li>- The purpose of the cutting;</li> </ul> <p><i><a href="#">The map illustrating the wooded areas and metropolitan forest corridors can be consulted here.</a></i></p>
